FAQ

Q. Do I have to pay multiple supply fees?

A. No, you only pay 1 supply fee regardless if you register for multiple school age programs.

Q. Do you prorate weeks?

A. No, your rate is weekly. We do not prorate regardless of attendance. We do allow 2 personal weeks per school year.

Q. What is your cancellation policy?

A. You must cancel via email to salee-byyouth@ymcaofthesandhills.org, written cancellation must be 7 days before the automatic draft. We auto draft on the Friday before the week starts.

Q. Do I pay during breaks, holidays, or teacher work days?

A. No, we follow the Harnett County School Calendar—this includes Linden Oak schools. If there is no school due to holidays, inclement weather, or any teacher related holidays we will not have programs.

Q. What about teacher work days?

A. We will offer special teacher work day programs at the Saleeby Branch only. There will be separate registration and cost; \$30 (members) \$35 (nonmembers).

Q. How do I pay?

A. During registration you will create an account or if you are a member, use your account that was created when you joined. You must have a valid credit/debit card or Bank (EFT) on file. We will automatically draft on the Friday before the school week. Please note that if your method of payment changes please email saleebyyouth@ymcaofthesandhills.org.

Q. What activities will my child be doing?

A. Your child's activities will include stem, crafts, and physical games. There are areas for homework time, but we cannot offer one-on-one help due to ratio.

Q. Can I volunteer?

Q. Will food be provided?

A. We will provide Super Snacks (Super Snacks is a Y term, it has the same components as a lunch) to all children included in registration these are USDA approved and consistent of all the USDA requirements for school aged children.
